




#### OFFICER-IN-CHARGE NAVAL PREP SCHOOL

#### LCDR. HENRY ORTLAND III

Mr. Ortland graduated from the United States Naval Academy in June of 1945. He then saw several tours at sea aboard numerous types of ships including the USS COWPENS aircraft carrier in the Pacific Fleet, and the USS CLIFFROSE in the Philippine area, and the destroyer USS SARSFIELD in the Atlantic Ocean. In 1948 Mr. Ortland served as an instructor at the U. S. Naval Academy in the department of Seamanship and Navigation. His next assignment was aboard the destroyer USS RUSH in Korean waters. In 1952 Mr. Ortland was assigned to the Staff of Commander Destroyer Flotilla Four. He then returned to the Naval Academy as an instructor, this time in the department of Marine Engineering. From the Naval Academy he was ordered to the U. S. Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island, as a student in the Command and Staff Course.

Upon completion of this course Mr. Ortland was assigned as Commanding Officer of the USS Bulwark, an ocean minesweeper. Mr. Ortland's present tour at Bainbridge began September 1958 following this command at sea.

#### MR. C. L. McGHEE

Mr. McGhee's service to his country started many years ago in 1918 when he first entered the Naval Academy. Graduating with the Class of 1922, Mr. McGhee began a long and distinguished career of service.

During World War II, from June 1941 until September 1946, Mr. McGhee instructed at the Naval Academy, preparing Midshipmen for their duties as officers in the service of their country. For the past thirteen years he has been Academic Director of the United States Naval Preparatory School.

The personal interest that Mr. McGhee has taken with each and every candidate at NPS is particularly noteworthy. His counseling and direction, which have been given to literally thousands of young Midshipman aspirants over the years, have been of invaluable assistance to them all.

#### MAJOR W. K. ROCKEY

Major Rockey started his military career by joining the Marine Corps in 1945. After a year he went to the Naval Academy Preparatory School, then located at Camp Perry, Virginia. Upon graduating from the Prep School, he attended the Naval Academy for four years.

After his graduation, Major Rockey attended Basic School at Quantico, Virginia. In 1951 he took command of Company "E," First Marine Regiment in Korea.

From 1952 to 1955, Major Rockey served as an instructor in the Tactics Section at Basic School, Quantico, Virginia. It was during this period that Major Rockey was promoted to First Lieutenant and Captain.

In the years 1955-1957 he was in command of the Marine Detachment aboard the USS SALEM, flagship of the Sixth Fleet in the Mediterranean. Transferred to the Second Marines, Second Marine Division, Camp LeJeune, North Carolina, Major Rockey served in various capacities of command until transferred to Junior School in 1959. In 1960, he was assigned as head of the algebra department here. At the beginning of 1961, he was promoted to major and assumed his present position.








